Jason Shellaby is a Project Manager at the Novartis Foundation, currently working on the national scale-up of the telemedicine project in Ghana, as well as the coordination of the Foundation's multi-stakeholder platform to address hypertension in urban settings in low- and middle-income countries. He is responsible for this initiative's implementation in Dakar, Senegal.

Prior to joining the Novartis Foundation in September 2016, Jason served as Deputy Director and Director of External Relations at Village Health Works, supporting the scale up and capacity building for both their headquarters in NYC and operations in Burundi, East Africa. Before Village Health Works, he was a Program Fellow at the Clinton Global Initiative where he was in charge of designing and implementing the program content for their Annual Meeting. Jason also worked at the World Economic Forum as a Project Associate in the Environmental Initiatives team, where he engaged leaders from NGOs, foundations, business, and governments to advance best practices and build public-private partnerships.
